YOUR CAR

NEVER, ever drink and drive

Our message is very simple. Drinking and driving kills and maims, wrecking families and communities - NEVER, ever Drink and drive.

Presents left in full view

Keep presents out of sight - if they can be seen they can be stolen.

Protect your keys

Never leave keys in the ignition - even for a short period eg. garage forecourts.

Car left unlocked

Always close windows, Engage steering lock and lock all doors.

Jack Frost

Don't leave your vehicle unattended and running on frosty mornings.

Parked in a secluded area

Park in a well lit area or in an attended car park.

Doors & Windows not secured

Ensure all doors and windows are locked.

Presents should be kept out of view.

Car keys and handbags conveniently placed

Never leave cars key or handbags in view of windows and doors.

Going on Holiday - Consider using automatic lights, cancel milk and papers, notify your local police and ask a neighbour to keep an eye on the house.

Opening your doors to strangers

Only open your door after identifying the caller, Not sure? Don't open the door or put the door chain on.

Large amounts of cash left at home

Do not leave large amounts of cash at home - use a bank/building society.
