Harry Ferguson Memorial Pipe Band Sun 28 June

Garvey Silver Band Sun 19 July

Garvey Silver Band was formed in 1993 as an amalgamation of two old silver bands, Lurganure and Lisburn Silver Bands, from the Lisburn area.

Drumlough Pipe Band Sun 26 July

Drumlough Pipe Band was formed in 1950 and had its first public appearance in 1951. The Patron of the band in its formative years was Harry Ferguson (The inventor of the Massey Ferguson Tractor!).

Ballycoan Flute Band Sun 2 August

Ballycoan Flute Band was formed in 1951 by a number of local lads. Over the years the band has fulfilled engagements throughout Northern Ireland, as well as England and Scotland. In 2011, the band celebrated its 60th Anniversary.

Baillies Mills Accordion Band Sun 9 August

Baillies Mills has been in existence since 1939 bringing pleasure and enjoyment, through music, to audiences throughout Northern Ireland and beyond.

Garvey Silver Band Sun 16 August

Garvey Silver Band plays an extensive modern repertoire of light and popular music (both classical and original brass) as well as film themes, marches and hymn tunes with something for all tastes.
